GMRS Repeater Status: KA2BYU reported on progress on the GMRS Repeater Network in the Keys. All the Repeaters are operating with the exception of Ocean Reef and Cudjoe Key. Some are on temporary antennas.

Ham Repeater Status: The Marathon DMR Repeater is back online but a bit deaf. Will work on the Marathon DMR Repeater when I return in early June. The Kew West DMR Repeater also appears to be a bit deaf. Will attempt to work on it in early June. The Cudjoe Key DMR Repeater is working really well with coverage up to the west half of the Seven Mile Bridge.

The Diex DXS-1 20-15-10 Meter Rotatable Dipole has been ordered and shipping is now delayed to July.
