Old Business:

W4KWS has started working on the Wacky Award Diploma graphics using Al and the Club's Logo. K1ST checked with K4HG on the original Wacky Award rules and they were very simple: a minimum of Five Keys and no using Repeaters. **We would like to know if anyone plans to pursue this award. Let K1ST know. If no one is interested this effort will be shelved.**

New Business:

GMRS Repeater Status from KA2BYU. ORC GMRS Repeater may have a blown Power Amplifier. **K1ST to check.**

Ham Repeater Status from K1ST. The Scout Island UHF FM Repeater was repaired 9/05. The Scout VHF FM Repeater's Receiver was replaced with a New Old Stock (NOS) and working well.

The potential tower work on the Grassy Key Tower for the VHF FM has been delayed as the tower crew left the Keys. They will be back in October. We need to check the one spare feedline on the tower before we consider hiring the tower crew to install a new <u>VHF Antenna</u>.

KQ4IMK has offered to help the Club get started in <u>Meshtastic</u>. Mshtastic is an Open Source 900 MHz unlicensed service. There is a lot of activity in the Miami Dade Area. Is anyone interested? **Contact KQ4IMK**



Hamshack Hotline went offline on August 28th. We have switched our VOIP Infrastructure to <u>HamsOverIP</u> (HOIP). HOIP is free and doesn't require you to have a physical phone first like Hamshack Hotline did. You can use the <u>Groundwire</u> app on your cell phone. The Goundwire app costs \$9.99. We can provide you with help in setting up your Groundwire App or VOIP Physical Phone.

We have a HOIP RF Link to the FM Repeater Network at ext 15130 and are working to add one to the DMR Keys Talk Group. The HOIP ext at the EOC Radio Room is 102455. We have also added an FKARC Conference Bridge at ext 10419 (Pin Number Required). There is a <u>Club Member HOIP directory</u> you can add to your VOIP physical Phone.

The VARA FM Gateway, KW4EOC was installed on September 13th in the EOC Radio Room in Marathon and is accessible on the County Wide FM Repeater Netowrk.
